

Terms & Conditions

General

1. Welcome to the Artlist Women Creator Fund (hereinafter: "Fund") video application(hereinafter: "Application") organized by Artlist Ltd (hereinafter: "Organizer").
2. Participation in the Application is subject to these Terms and conditions (hereinafter: "Terms"). The Terms constitute a legally binding agreement for all intents and purposes between the participant (hereinafter: "You") and the Organizer.
3. The Application is open to women only, who are video creators having a dream to create a video based on "VOICE" theme.

Requirements for participation

4. In order to participate in the Application You will be required to submit the following:
 - a. explain your idea in a short video (2 minutes max) . The idea must be based on the theme of "Voice".
 - b. submit creative references including an explanation of shooting techniques and an outline of the final video and/or a visual reference brief/documents submit a short document with a
 - c. description about yourself and previous work if you have. (hereinafter: " Materials").
5. The Organizer will choose Materials of 3 winners and will grant them the prizes (as detailed below) which will enable and assist them to create a short video in (at a 7 minutes length maximum) and a trailer (at a 1 min length max), based on your Materials ("the Project")
6. Winners will receive a prize including equipment and professional one-on-one mentoring and guidance in order to create their Project
7. Winner undertakes to be available for the duration of the Project's creation according to the time table below, and to create and provide the Project according to Fund's schedule as detailed below.
8. By applying, sharing your dream with us, and sending us the Materials, you approve all these Terms and agree to be bound and comply with all of them, especially with regard to the realization of the prize schedule.
9. The Organizer reserves the right to modify or cancel the Application and/or the

Eligibility

10. On the closing date of Materials submission, you must be a woman 18 years of age or older.
11. You approve that there is no legal prohibition on your participation in the Application.
12. You must fulfill all the terms and conditions of participation.

13. Employees of the Organizer or of the Sponsors and or of the Mentors and their family members are not eligible to participate.

Time Table

14. The Application will be held as follows:
 - launch: March 3rd, 2022
 - Application submission deadline: March 22th, 2022
 - Fund winners announcement: Early April, 2022.
 - the mentoring process included in the prize will take place during a period of 3 months from April to July 2022.
 - End of July 2022 - Showcasing the winners' Projects.
15. The Organizer may change any of the dates specified herein upon its sole discretion.
16. Any material uploaded or submitted following the deadline date and time will not be eligible for a prize.
17. The Organizer will bear no responsibility in case Materials were not received to Organizer for whatever reason.
18. The decision whether a certain material will participate or not will be made only by the Organizer and shall be final. Without detracting from the above, the Organizer reserves the right to decide whether certain material may not participate in the Application at its sole discretion and for any reason (including for technical, procedural or substantive reason) and may disqualify a video that the Organizer believes might defame any person or entity and/or infringe upon, misappropriate and/or violate the rights of any person or entity or promote of improper objectives (such as promoting violence, hurting the helpless and so on).

Awards and Prizes

Generally

The prize will include "tools" that will be provided to you by the Organizer, in order for your dream to come true. Upon notification of you winning the prize, you agree to the following:

- creating your project including a short video (7 minutes length maximum) and a trailer (1 min length max) based on your Material.
- the Project will have 1x1 and 16x9 versions
- The Project must include music and stock footage from Organizer's sites only (<https://artist.io/> and <https://artgrid.io/>). SFX will be either from the Organizer's catalog or made by you (use of other SFX catalogs is strictly prohibited). You can include in the Project additional elements, including, but not limited to, templates, 3D elements, VFX to which you are the owner of and/or have the rights in and/or have the relevant license to use.
- You will be invited to participate in a YouTube and/or Instagram live video announcing the winners
- The organizer will hold all rights in the Project (as detailed below) , and will be allowed (among other things) to use the Project on its social media platforms.
- Artist can add other elements to the Materials/Projects.

The prizes are non-transferable and provide "as is". Organizer is not responsible for any prize supplied by any third party and makes no warranty, guarantee or representation of any kind concerning the Prize (or any portion thereof) and disclaims any implied warranty.

Delivery of Prizes

19. Prizes will be sent to the physical address specified in the contact details you provided in your Application for the Fund. You are obliged to provide full and complete details of your physical address. The absence of a physical address and/or a physical address that is incomplete or inaccurate may deny the right to receive a prize. You understand the prizes will be sent by a third party and that the Organizer has no involvement or control over the delivery. The Organizer will not be liable in any circumstances for the consequences of any delay in delivery. To the extent that the release of the prize involves the payment of customs duty this tax will apply to you only.
20. Mentoring engagement will be by Organizer and on its behalf, including initial introduction and scheduling of frame-work according to Application and Fundschedule.

Taxation

21. All taxes whose application is either directly or indirectly connected to the awarding of any of the prizes shall be charged to the winners. You understand that you are solely responsible for any and all federal, state and local taxes, fees and assessments of any governmental authority (including, without limitation, customs taxes, if and to the extent applicable) on any prizes that you

may be awarded in connection with your participation in the Application and/or winning any of the prizes. Winners may be required to sign, at the request of and in the sole discretion of the Organizer, a Release and/or a Prize Acceptance Form in order to receive the Prize.

Warranties and Obligations

22. By submitting the Materials to the Organizer and receiving the prizes, you assign and transfer to the Organizer all copyrights in the Materials and Project as well as all now known or hereafter existing rights of every kind and nature throughout the universe in perpetuity and in all languages, pertaining to the Materials and Project. Without limiting the foregoing, to the extent any Material/ Project is not deemed to be exclusively owned by the Organizer, you hereby make a full, irrevocable assignment, in perpetuity, to the Organizer of all such Materials/Project, to be used by Organizer (among other ways) on its social media platforms and/or in Organizer paid marketing campaigns. If any Materials and Project is not assignable to the Organizer, you hereby grant to Organizer a perpetual, irrevocable, fully paid-up, royalty-free, fully transferable, sublicensable, exclusive, worldwide right and license, free from any liens or encumbrances, to use, reproduce, distribute, display and perform (whether publicly or otherwise), prepare derivative works of, otherwise enhance or modify, synchronize and otherwise exploit all or any portion of such Materials and Project.

You hereby unconditionally and irrevocably waive the enforcement of "droit moral" rights, "moral rights of authors" or any similar rights with respect to attribution of authorship or integrity relating to the Materials and Project against Organizer and its exhibitors, broadcasters, publishers, licensees, users and other distributors.
24. You represent and warrant to the Organizer that: (a) your Application for the Fund and your obligations in accordance with these Terms do not and will not violate, conflict with, or result in a breach under any other agreement to which you are a party or by which you or the Materials and Project is/are or may become subject or bound; (b) you have all necessary rights to grant the rights and perform your obligation under this Terms without any third party participation or approvals; (c) you will not grant any rights under any future agreement, nor will it permit or suffer any new lien, obligation, or encumbrances that will conflict with the full enjoyment by the Organizer of the rights granted to the Organizer under this Terms; (d) you have and will have all requisite ownership, rights, and licenses to fully perform your obligations under this Terms and to grant to the Organizer all rights with respect to the copyrights, trademark rights and other intellectual property and/or proprietary right of any third party granted under this Terms, free and clear of any and all agreements, liens, adverse claims, encumbrances, and interests of any person or entity; (e) no part of any Materials and/or Project shall or will defame any person or entity and/or infringe upon, misappropriate and/or violate the rights of any person or entity, including, without limitation, any Intellectual Property Right(s), right(s) of privacy and/or right(s) of publicity of any third party;
25. You hereby unconditionally and irrevocably waive any claim or demand for any improper use of the Materials and Project, as well as regarding any matter related to the Application and Fund, inclusive of, without limitation, its operation, Terms and any other matter related thereto.
26. You shall, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Organizer and its affiliates, and its and their respective directors, shareholders, officers, agents, employees, licensees, judges of the panel, successors and assigns from and against any and all damages, costs, liabilities, losses, and expenses resulting from any claim, suit, action, or proceeding brought by a third party arising out of, relating to and/or in connection with, directly or indirectly, (a) any breach or alleged breach of any of the representations and/or warranties made by you under this Terms; (b) any breach or

alleged breach of this Terms by you;

27. You agree that the Organizer will be entitled to use your name and/or image and/or photos for presentation and promotion of the Application and Funds and announcement of the winners, if and to the extent the Organizer may desire, at its exclusive discretion. Your full name and full contact information may be also disclosed in order to comply with law enforcement, court orders or legal process.
28. You understand and agree that you will receive no compensation in connection with your participation in the Application, the assignment and transfer of all rights in the Materials and/or Project and the use of the Materials and/or Project and your name and likeness.
29. The laws of the State of Israel will exclusively apply to these Terms and the competent Court in Tel-Aviv – Yaffo only, and no other Court anywhere else, will hold unique and exclusive jurisdiction to hear any matter resulting from these Terms or involved in same (including any issue relating to the Application and/or the Fund and/or to the Materials and/or Project), whether directly or indirectly.
30. Any notice sent by email to the email provided by you will be considered to have reached its destination and read within 24 hours from its dispatch and will be considered as lawful service for any purpose and intent.
